

## PRIVACY STATEMENT SELFIE CONTEST

### 1. Privacy Clause

Erasmus+ OLS attributes great importance to the protection of personal data. We use and process your personal data exclusively in accordance with the general regulation regarding data protection and other relevant applicable national provisions of law. Every reference to 'Regulation' in this Privacy Statement is a reference to the EU Regulation of 27<sup>th</sup> April 2016, concerning the protection of physical persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data.
